Return to Play Overview

- All players, parents, spectators, staff, board members will be required to submit a signed waiver provided by FYSA in order to participate or enter our facility. The waiver will be on our website. Please bring a signed waiver to the facility when you arrive.
- All players will have to check in at their assigned field each practice, where it will be documented if they have submitted a waiver previously.
- Players who are feeling sick or have a family member that is sick are expected to remain home and not attend practice sessions.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the fields for participants. We recommend that anyone that enters the soccer facilities to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- Bathroom facilities will be open but strict social distancing rules will be in place.
- Players will have specific areas to enter fields and spectators will have specific areas to watch practice from.
- No player contact will be permitted until further notice. Practice sessions will adhere to 6' social distancing.
- Coaches will manage the practice sessions in accordance with Hillsborough County return to play protocols.
- Staff, Parent/Spectators will be required to wear a mask.

Facility Entry and Exit Plan

- An identified drive in entrance/exit to the park and a designated entry/exit for each field
- Anyone who enters facility will have temperature checked upon arrival
- Staff, Volunteers, Participants and/or Parent/Guardian/Spectator will have to acknowledge answers to a CoVid-19 questionnaire before entry
- Questions will be sent to parents in advance
- Entrance to the park will maintain social distancing requirements
- All facilities and gates will be locked/secured after use
- Facility Maps are are posted on the website.

Facility Attendance

- Anyone who attends practice session at facility will enter through designated entrance area
- Roster/Attendance will be kept for each scheduled practice for each team to assist with contact tracing
- Only participants and staff allowed inside playing areas (field) at this time
- Participants will have a check in area at each field
- Spectators will have designated areas to sit and watch from, maintaining social distancing policy.
- Facility attendance sheet will be kept each night of participants and staff at facility
- 30 minute transition time between sessions

Questionnaire

Participant and/or Parent/Guardian/Spectator will have to acknowledge answers to these questions upon entrance to facility

- 1) Have you had a sore throat, fever, aches in the past 24 hours?
- 2) Has anyone in your household been ill?
- 3) Have you been around anyone with a confirmed CoVid case?
- 4) Have you traveled out of the country in the past month?
- 5) Has anyone in your household traveled outside of the county in the past month

Return to Play – Practice Sessions

There will be a weekly training schedule that is distributed for the week for practice sessions

We will provide a waiver from FYSA (Florida Youth Soccer Association) that must be signed for all participants, parents, volunteers, board members and staff

- Only practice sessions that can maintain social distancing and group size restrictions will be permitted at this time
- Group, parent or team meetings will be online until further notice
- Practice session will consist of
 - o Strict adherence to the 6' social distancing policy
 - o Not team huddles
 - o No player contact
 - o Groups of 10 or less on a half of a full-size soccer field. Minimizing of shared equipment
- Coaches will be required to wear masks

Inclement Weather Protocol

Due to the CoVid-19 pandemic, We will provide cancellation of events with adequate time before the start of the scheduled event if inclement weather is expected.

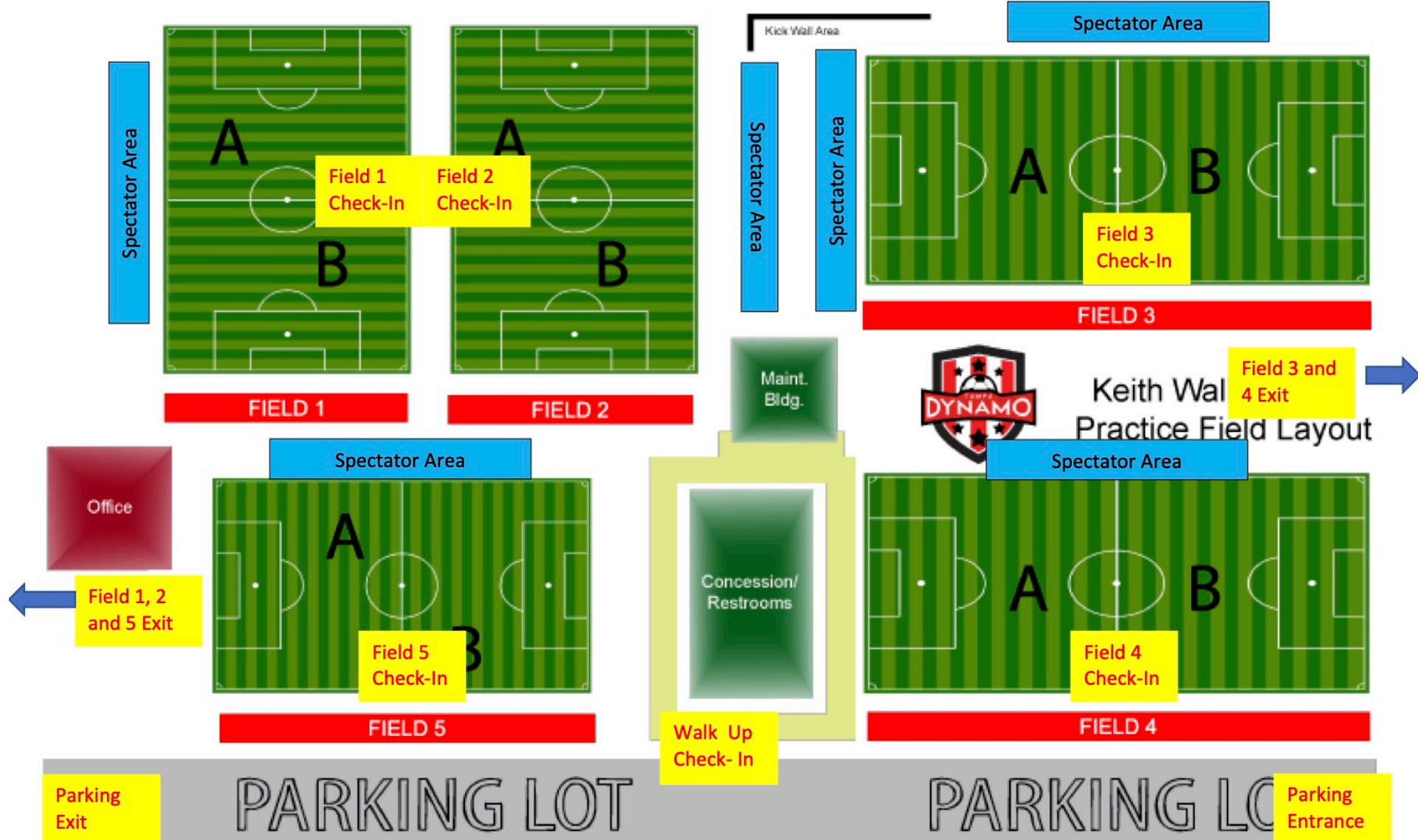
- If inclement weather forces a clearing of the fields during a session, the participants will return to their cars and that session will be cancelled.
- If inclement weather forces a clearing of the fields during the first scheduled event of a night, the second scheduled practice for the night will be cancelled.
- Parents will be required to stay at the fields during their participants scheduled practice.
- If a participant's parent is unavailable to take participant home, indoor facilities will be opened up for safety. Parents will be contacted for pickup.
- Indoor facilities will be pre-setup to ensure social distancing requirements can be maintained.
- Please sign up for inclement weather alerts to be notified of a cancelled practice due to inclement weather. RAINED OUT
- Other communication for cancellation due to inclement weather will be:
 - Team coaches and managers will be notified of any cancellation of events
 - Field closed notice will be updated on our website

CoVid-19 Case Reporting

A positive case of CoVid-19 must be reported to Board of Directors.

- Case will be documented and player will be identified on roster/attendance sheet for no participation until cleared by the club
- Parent/Guardian/Player will be notified of below procedure before they can return
 - No return to play for any reported positive case for 14 days
 - A doctor's note will be needed to be cleared to participate again
- Membership will be notified of a positive case and when that participant was at the facility
- HCPRD Athletics office will be notified
